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overview

The Bachelor's degree in Economics and Management is awarded by Université Paris Cité and is taught in French at Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi by internationally renowned professors.

The Bachelor's degree in Economics and Management offers a comprehensive and progressive three-year programme, combining fundamental teaching in economics, management and quantitative methods. It is aimed at students who wish to understand economic and managerial mechanisms while developing analytical and cross-disciplinary skills adapted to contemporary issues. The teaching approach combines lectures and tutorials, promoting autonomy and critical thinking. Throughout the programme, students benefit from an international and multicultural learning environment that promotes open-mindedness and mobility.

In the first year, students acquire the essential basics: an introduction to economics, management, applied mathematics and statistics, supplemented by courses in law and economic history. Particular attention is paid to language skills and digital tools, which are essential in an international academic and professional environment.

The second year deepens theoretical and applied knowledge. Students study public economics, economic policy, general accounting, as well as probability and statistics for economics. The curriculum also covers finance, business law and organisational management, broadening students' career prospects.

In the third year, the programme focuses on specialisation and application. Students study microeconomics of finance, econometrics, cost accounting, and various complementary subjects (marketing, strategic management, international economics, etc.). This final year allows students to consolidate their analytical skills, strengthen their practice of quantitative methods, and explore more advanced topics related to global economic challenges.

Courses are taught in French and meet the standards of excellence and rigour specific to the French education system. Students also benefit from a tutoring system, either in groups or individually. The curriculum follows the European ECTS credit system.




Career prospects

This high quality programme provides numerous opportunities across a spectrum of industries including the public sector, enterprise services, financial institutions, banks and insurance companies as well as multinational corporations.

Career options include positions in international organisations (e.g. OECD, WTO), Economic Analysts, Market and Sales Analysts in the private and public sector and Financial Managers in corporate entities.

This degree provides graduates with several options to pursue further academic studies at Sorbonne Abu Dhabi (Master in Banking and Finance: Law and Regulations of Banking and Financial Systems, Master in Marketing, Advertising and Communication, Master in Health Economics, Master in Applied Foreign Languages: Speciality Management and International Business) and other overseas institutions.





Admission requirements

To be eligible for this Bachelor's degree, students must have the following :

- French baccalaureate: minimum average of 12 out of 20.
- Ministry of Education curriculum: General stream/Art stream: minimum average of 80%. Advanced stream/Elite stream/Science stream: minimum average of 75%.
- Other high school systems: high school certificate equivalent to the UAE Ministry of Education high school with minimum average of 80% or equivalent
- French Aptitude Certificate: minimum score of B2 level (DELFI or DALF, SELFEE, TCF with a validity of 2 years, TEF with a validity of 2 years) or completion of SUAD university diploma DU in French language for non-French speakers. Students with a French Baccalaureate are exempted from the language proficiency exam.
- A minimum average of 75% (or equivalent) in Mathematics subject in high school is required or SAT Mathematics at and above 485.
- Mathematics entry test is required for students scoring between 69 and 74.9 (or equivalent) in Mathematics subject in high school or SAT Mathematics score between 450 and 485. Students not meeting the required French Aptitude Certificate will be admitted conditionally in the programme, and enrolled in the foundation year in intensive French providing they meet the below criteria:
- Ministry of Education curriculum: General stream/Art stream: minimum average of 80%. Advanced stream/Elite stream/Science stream: minimum average of 75%.
- Other high school systems: high school certificate equivalent to the UAE Ministry of Education high school with minimum average of 80% or equivalent .
- A minimum average of 75% (or equivalent) in Mathematics subject in school systems is required or SAT Mathematics at and above 485 Upon its successful completion, they will be admitted into the bachelor degree programme.
